

ORDINANCE NO. 707

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A JOINT CITY-COUNTY
MUSEUM COMMISSION IN DALLES CITY, APPOINTING
MEMBERS THERETO, SETTING THE DATES ON WHICH THE
TERMS OF MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION EXPIRE, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

The people of Dalles City do ordain as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby established in Dalles City a joint city-county museum commission with Wasco County under and pursuant to ORS 358.310 to 358.405, contingent upon Wasco County by appropriate action appointing and formulating such a joint museum commission as a participant therein. Members shall be appointed in cooperation with the county by the council. [Section 1, as amended by Ordinance No. 739, passed August 19, 1957.]

Section 2. The joint city-county museum commission shall exercise such powers as are conferred upon it by ORS 358.310 to 358.405. [Section 2, as amended by Ordinance No. 739, passed August 19, 1957.]

Section 3. Inasmuch as it is necessary and desirable that a museum commission be set up, it being in the public interest that all things of a historical nature be preserved and protected for the benefit of the public, therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
